Guidelines and Rules of the Photo Contest

FIFTH STATE LEVEL PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION 2019-20

M.L.V. Tribal Research & Training Institute, Udaipur invites entries for 5th State Level Photography Contest on the theme "Tribal folk deities and their places of worship". Amateur photographers especially tribals are invited to compete.

THEME - "Tribal folk deities and their places of worship"

GUIDELINES AND RULES :-

1. There is no entry fee.
2. The competition is open to amateur photographers. Amateurs being persons who do not earn their livelihood essentially out of photography.
3. Employees and the immediate family members of Tribal Welfare Department are not eligible to apply.
4. The competition will have only one category i.e. colour photograph. Format acceptable is portrait or landscape.
5. "Tribal folk deities and their places of worship" here means only "Tribal Folk deities and their places of worship", tribal's of Rajasthan state only.
6. Photographers are invited to send colour prints along with detail in maximum 100 words with photograph size 8"x10" on matt finish paper together with a good quality digital image (jpeg format not less than 300 dpi, with the smaller size not less than 2400 pixels) in a CD.
7. Photos/CDs submitted will not be returned to the entrants.
8. Photographers can send maximum 2 (two) photographs but no entry should be mounted or with any kind of border, frame etc.
9. Due priority will be given to rare known "Tribal folk deities and their places of worship"

10. Each entry (photograph) should also be accompanied by a brief note in attached format on A-4 size paper describing the "Tribal folk deities and their places of worship", location of photography, tribal community etc.
11. Each entry should accompany a CD. On which name of photographer and mobile number and number of photograph must be written.
12. Only title of the photograph should be written on back of the photograph but authors' identity should not be disclosed on photograph.
13. Below each brief note author of photograph should submit a certificate confirming that the entrant is the author of the photograph, and he/she has not violated any law in taking the photograph. Also agreeing that the T.R.I. will not be responsible for any claims/suit challenging the authorship, or infringement on the privacy of any person clearly recognizable in the photograph(s) submitted.
14. T.R.I. reserves the right to use these photographs for any publicity/ documentation purposes.
15. No other payment except for the prize winning entries as mentioned above will be made.
16. Not more than one award will be given to one person.
17. T.R.I. will not be responsible for any kind of damage or loss in transit.
18. Entries received after the closing date will not be entertained.
19. A prize distribution ceremony and an exhibition of selected entries will be conducted by T.R.I.
20. The entries will be judged by a Jury. The decision of the judges will be final and no queries or objections will be entertained.
21. By sending entries to this competition a photographer explicitly accepts the terms and conditions stated herein.
22. The entries should be submitted in person or by post in a sealed packet/envelope super scribed with the words
"Entries for the Fifth Photography Contest: " Tribal folk deities and their places of worship " and address to the Director, M.L.V. Tribal Research & Training Institute, Ashok Nagar Main Road, Post box no. 86. Udaipur (Raj.)
23. Only sealed packet/envelope entries will be entertained.
24. Mounted or framed photographs will be rejected without any consideration.
25. Last date of sending entries is 30 September. 2019.
